2024 was a busy year!

-  We held discounted spay/neuter clinics in Moab, Green River, and Blanding.
-  We increased awareness for our cause during fundraisers and events at: Moab Easter Jeep Safari, Wabi Sabi, Moab Folk Festival, Moab Free Concert Series, Green River Melon Days, and the Moab Holiday Parade.
-  We held our annual fundraising brunch, *Paws for the Cause*, at the Desert Bistro in Moab and a fundraiser at *Twice Upon a Time*, thrift store in Green River.
-  We initiated a feral cat trap, neuter, return program in Green River.
-  We continued to take cats to Petco in Grand Junction for adoption which makes more room for more cats at the shelter.
-  The Board of Directors worked hard to oversee the organization and updated our Financial Policy, Investment Policy, and Strategic Plan.
-  Thanks to our volunteers who donated 5,000 hours this year. And thanks to **Grand County** and the **Red Rock 4-Wheelers** for their continued support.

What your donations achieved in 2024

- ❖ **90** dogs and cats placed in forever homes
- ❖ **160** community dog and cats spay/neutered
- ❖ **285** community (feral) cats spay/neutered
- ❖ **2,110** lbs. free dog and cat food given to families needing a helping hand to keep pets in their home

We are proud that we completed the Utah Non Profits Association Credential Program, earned a platinum rating on Candid (Guidestar), and are an accredited charity with the Utah Better Business Bureau.

Earning the UNA Credential Program Badge required completing nine courses in different disciplines to create financial accountability, transparency, and a culture of excellence for the organization. It took us 5 years, but we did it!!!
